 - Create one slide for the analytics method and one for the application [8 slides]
- Analytics method 5
 - o create two slides for the analytics method and one for the application [3 slides]
- Reflect and list the limitations of the analytics methods chosen [1-2 slides]
- Discuss in short sentence form possible ethical, legal and privacy issues [1-2 slides]
