Your presentation should include the following slide format:

  - Create one slide for the analytics method and one for the application **[8 slides]**
- Analytics method 5
  - create two slides for the analytics method and one for the application **[3 slides]**
- Reflect and list the limitations of the analytics methods chosen **[1-2 slides]**
- Discuss in short sentence form possible ethical, legal and privacy issues **[1-2 slides]**
