Assessment Task 2: Global Health Report



Task Rationale

The strategies used to tackle global health problems take many forms and have varying levels of success. These strategies may be developed and/or implemented by local communities, national and international, or private organisations. Although these strategies are designed to improve the population's health, they may not be as effective as planned or have unintended consequences.

Assessment task: Written report

Instruction: The task is to create a report on one strategy that addresses a global

health problem in a country other than Australia.

Students are to evaluate the development and implementation of the strategy and how it addresses the needs of the population of

interest. The report is to be formatted using the

template located on Learnline.

Word limit: 2000 words. Headings, tables, figures, and in-text citations are

included in the word count; the reference page is not (a word count

that is outside the ±10% range will lead to a reduction of 10% of the total mark available for the assessment)

Font: Times New Roman or Calibri 12

Line Spacing: 1.5 or double

Reference system: APA 7th (minimum 10 credible references no older than ten

years old)

Header: Student ID (digits), unit code

Footer: page number

File format/submission: .doc or docx. To be submitted via Turnitin





Assessment criteria

Knowledge

Students are required to submit an assignment on $\underline{\text{one}}$ of the following topic areas

- Mental health
 - Discuss the emerging trend for the use of psychedelic drugs as therapeutic agents in mental health and their history
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Heath
 - Discuss public health challenges for fresh drinking water, and compare access to fresh drinking water for remote communities and third world countries
- Infectious disease
 - Polio has recently been discovered during wastewater testing in New York state. Compare management of Polio eradication approaches in low-income countries to high income countries.
- Pandemic
 - Monkey pox has been declared a pandemic by the World Health Organisation. Discuss a strategy that has been implemented by the WHO to address this pandemic
- Non-Communicable Diseases
 - Critically appraise the different public health approaches to addressing Trachoma with reference to one tropical low- or middle-income country and Australia
- Health Protection
 - The supreme court of America has overturned Roe Vs Wade.
 This has far reaching consequences for women seeking to terminate pregnancy. Discuss how this may impact third world countries that America provides health aid to.

Make clear links between the strategy and the healthcare problem, supporting the report with relevant population data and global health-related statistics.

These can be in the form of tables or graphs.
